The Eco Camp at a glance

The Eco Camp is ideal for student groups and is the base for Eco-training in Kenya.

There are a total of 8 rooms and can accommodate up to 16 guests. There are 4 twin rooms, 2 triple rooms and 2 single rooms. These rooms share a shower block of 4 showers and a toilet block with 4 toilets.

There are also 2 twin ensuite rooms (trainers rooms).

Excluded: Soft drinks, local beers, wines and spirits, champagne and premium spirits for which there is a cash bar. Any other park or access fee for conservancies and the Masai Mara National Reserve. Hot-air balloons, Rhino Sanctuary entrance fees, visit to the Mara Elephant Project, Vehicle hire for game drives and airstrip transfers US\$250 per vehicle per day, tips and donations.

- 1 Bookings are accepted on the understanding that guests have their own comprehensive travel insurance with at least cover for Medical, Repatriation and Cancellation included. The policy number, Insurance Provider, and emergency contact information, to be provided before the commencement of the journey.
